- Create your own turtle shell backpack costume. Tip: To make your party even more
 environmentally friendly encourage your guests to bring old clothes, curtains or any fabric
 material that can be reused to create turtle shell backpacks.
- Trick-or-treat with reusable bags.
- Hand out and serve organic candy and healthy treats that use as little packaging as possible.
- Use cups, plates, utensils and napkins made from recycled or sustainable materials. Tip: use products manufactured from corn resin or sugar-cane stalk. Items labeled "biodegradable" or "100 percent recycled content" are also sustainable.
- Buy your pumpkin from a local farmer's market or pumpkin patch.
- Serve guests with food that is in season: pumpkin, acorn squash, sweet potato, pears and apples.
- Make sure glass, paper and plastic products are recycled at the end of the party.
- Reuse all of your spooky Halloween decorations next year.

After the party is done and the last person is out the door, don't forget to use your organic cleaners to tidy up the house. Using organic products is a great way to reduce the amount of chemicals in your home and in the environment.

Planning and throwing environmentally-friendly parties helps you give back to the environment by educating guests about how simple it can be to live sustainably. Sea turtles are affected by garbage and debris in the ocean and need your help, no matter how far away from an ocean you are, to promote sustainability in order to give them a fighting chance.
