Jellyfish Windsock

- 1. Take two clear kitchen trash bags, crumple one of the bags into a ball and stuff it into the corner of the other bag.
- 2. Tape around the bottom of the ball to form a neck.
- 3. Cut part of the trash bag hanging down into long strips to make tentacles.
- 4. Push a string through the neck of the jellyfish and tie the two ends together to make a hanger for the windsock.
- 5. To make fish to get caught in the tentacles cut two identical shapes from cleat contact paper.
- 6. Peel the backing off one shape and decorate with colored tissue paper and sequins.
- 7. Cut out an eye and add a pupil.
- 8. Cover the decorated fish with the other piece on contact paper.
- 9. Staple the fish to the tentacle.
